Duct Tape Flower Pens

- 1) Measure a strip of tape to cover the pen from the base of the flower to near the pen point. Lay your pen on the tape and roll, wrapping your tape around the pen.
- 2) Cut at least 12 squares of duct tape. The more petals you have the bigger your flower will be.
- 3) To make the petals, take tape sticky side up and fold down one corner. Fold the other upper corner down, leaving a strip of adhesive exposed. Repeat for each petal.
- 4) Take a petal and wrap it around the nonink end of the pen. Continue to wrap each petal so the points are staggered.
- 5) For the base of the flower, cut 4 pieces of tape and make petal shapes. Attach to stem, covering the base of where the flowers attach to the pen.
